You tasked the Jury to consider a protest that control 207 was misplaced and failed the test of fairness.

The Jury investigated the matter in detail and considered the following points were most relevant to the protest:

- 1. Over 300 competitors visited the control in question and no other complaints were received;
- 2. Performance of other competitors on the same course did not appear to be impacted at that or the subsequent control;
- 3. The control and feature was only marginally displaced and was clearly visible from the position that was considered to be absolutely correct, moreover, the minimal displacement was within acceptable bounds of symbol based mapping and mapper's interpretation.

The options the Jury considered were: voiding courses that contained the control; removing splits to and from 207; and letting the results stand.

THE UNANIMOUS OPINION OF THE JURY IS THAT THE RESULTS SHOULD STAND WITHOUT ADJUSTMENT.

I would be grateful if you could pass the Jury's decision to the originator of the protest and the organiser.
